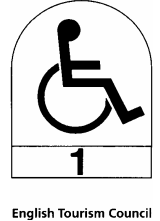

Fishing from beautiful Burgh

Burgh Castle Marina welcomes guests who are anglers and who wish to try some of the best angling to be found in the Anglian Region.

If you are a dedicated specimen hunter, predator fisherman or just prefer to while away an hour or two on the riverbanks, your needs are well catered for within a short distance of our Holiday Park.

Within a stone's throw of the entrance to our Park there are two venues where coarse species can be caught. The first and nearest to us is Burgh Castle Fishery, where you can expect Roach, Bream, Tench, Carp and Pike. A small daily charge is collected by the Bailiff on the bankside. You can easily walk to it via our approach road or Porters Loke and a few yards along Butt Lane. This venue would suit younger anglers - Silver Fish are usually queuing up for maggots!!

A further half mile along Butt Lane just past "Stepshort" in Belton village is Edward's Fishery - two pools which hold Carp, Tench, Roach, Rudd and a few hard to get Crucian Carp. This venue is also suitable for young anglers, although at this point it would be appropriate to remind parents that **any area of deep water is dangerous and that an accompanying adult is always recommended.** A small daily charge is also applicable at this venue.

Anglers with a more serious specimen type of water in mind are also catered for. Approximately one mile from our Park is Hall Farm Fishery; a very accessible water mainly aimed at the Carp angler, although Silver Fish, Tench and Bream can also be targeted. The average Carp caught on this venue is between 10 - 20lbs. This is a very pleasant spot with lots of swims available to the disabled angler. Tickets for Hall Farm are £3.00 per rod per day.

A huge lake (approximately two and a half miles long) is also situated within the grounds of Fritton Lake Country Park, a large country leisure complex about four miles from our Park off the A143 to Beccles. Coarse fishing is popular here and if you wish you can spend a very enjoyable day with all the family whilst partaking of some rod bending. Boats may also be hired at Fritton Country Park. A charge for fishing is made at the entrance Gate.

Within a half hour drive from our Park an angler can also "taste" the delights of most of the Norfolk Broads River Systems: the Rivers Ant, Thurne, Bure, Waveney and Yare. The latter is famous for its Bream catches in the warmer months. Anglers can even combine a shopping or sightseeing trip to Norwich with a spot of fishing while their partner is tramping the streets. There is a free stretch of the famed River Wensum right beside one of the Car Parks in the City of Norwich - drop the others off

then drop your rig in! Easy!! Roach, Bream, Hybrids, Chub and Dace abound in this favourite river of “T.V’s Mr Fishing” John Wilson. The whole riverside length in Norwich is free fishing, and pegs can be had most week-days (matches usually booked at the week-end).

Another superb venue within a half hour drive from Burgh Castle is a “Jewel” called “Golden Pond Fishery”. Situated within a stone’s throw from picturesque Hickling Broad, these small prolific ponds are kept as you would your own back garden. Beautifully manicured banks with secure, stable fishing platforms, make this 24 carat fishery supremely suitable for wheelchairs. This is a venue stuffed full of “fun” size carp that are really easy to catch and is well worth the drive.

Tackle and Bait are well looked after by the two local Tackle Shops, both within a short walk of the main car parks of Gorleston (the nearest Beach to our Park).

Finally we should also remind our sea angling friends that sea fishing trips, on fully insured craft, are always available from the quays in Gorleston and Great Yarmouth. Sea tackle and bait are available from the two shops mentioned previously.
